Report

The measurement of success for any community-based organization can be determined by how it fulfills its mission. For us at the United Jewish Federation, the essence of our mission is to build a strong Jewish community, both here in Pittsburgh, in Israel and throughout the world. However, we cannot have a vibrant Jewish community without committed Jews.

To meet this challenge, for the past two years, the UJF has been focused on outreach. How can we engage more people in Jewish life? How can we make our community more welcoming and inviting? How can we reach Jews where they live? How can we encourage more connections to formal and informal Jewish learning experiences?

In response, we called upon our Board of Delegates, representing every synagogue and Jewish organization in the Pittsburgh area, to launch a community-wide outreach effort. Through this collaborative effort, we sponsored a series of meetings and training sessions, secured foundation dollars and provided funding for a variety of innovative programs designed to welcome Jews who have heretofore been unengaged or minimally engaged. We are excited to see real results to this UJF initiative and we plan to continue to build upon our success.

Attendance at UJF events has grown markedly over the past year, with an estimated 5,000 people attending our Israel Independence Day festivities, more than 1,300 participating in a Community and Public Affairs community clean-up effort and 450 attending a Jewish Unity program. Attendance at our two-week long Jewish Israeli Film Festival increased by 25 percent and more than 250 young adults previously unknown to us connected to the UJF through a variety of Young Adult Division programs. Our volunteer ranks, overall, have swelled, with hundreds serving in various capacities. Lastly, through email, we are now reaching seven times more Jews than in 2005 with our UJF news and messaging.

Historically, our community has responded to critical needs in the Jewish world, and this past year was no exception as detailed in this report. When war broke out in Israel last year, the UJF raised \$5.5 million to support the social service needs in Israel's north, including our Partnership 2000 communities of Karmiel and Misgav. At that same time, we launched our 2007 Annual Community Campaign and reached our goal of \$12.4 million. We are especially appreciative to PNC Bank for a \$175,000 grant to the UJF Annual Campaign and to the Jewish Healthcare Foundation for its annual \$900,000 block grant for health-related needs in the community. Our UJF Foundation has secured more than \$16.8 million in new funds, surpassing its goal. Altogether, this past fiscal year, the UJF secured more than \$40 million, an all time high.

There are many great challenges to which your UJF continues to respond. We are helping Jews in need while we are also planning for a Jewish future. We are proud to have one of the most respected and emulated Federations in North America and be recognized as one of the leading philanthropies in our region. We appreciate the trust and confidence you place in us and as we go forward under the leadership of Daniel Shapira, the incoming Chair of the Board, we look forward to even more success as we respond to our historic mission.

The Community We Serve



Agency for Jewish Learning*

The community advocate for Jewish learning throughout Greater Pittsburgh. Provides ongoing formal and informal Jewish learning support for all community agencies, organizations, day schools and synagogues.

School of Advanced Jewish Studies (J-Site)

Serves as a supplementary high school for students in grades 8 through 12, offering Hebrew and Judaic studies, Hebrew language and college credit courses.

Aleph Institute

Reaches out to thousands of incarcerated Jews in our area and provides services to inmates and their families.

Chabad House on Campus

Provides a variety of social, educational and cultural programming for college students.

Community Day*

Serves as an independent, co-educational Jewish day school for kindergarten through grade 8.

Day School Scholarship Fund

Provides scholarships to students who qualify for assistance.

Greater Pittsburgh Rabbinic Association

Provides a forum for area rabbis to discuss issues of concern and promote joint initiatives.

Hebrew Free Loan Association

Makes small, interest-free loans for rehabilitation and self-support.

The Edward and Rose Berman Hillel Jewish University Center*

Serves Jewish students on area campuses by developing cultural, religious, social, and educational programs and by helping them access other Jewish community services.

Hillel Academy of Pittsburgh*

Provides Judaic, general, and college preparatory education for boys and girls in preschool through grade 12; grades 3 and up have separate classes for boys and girls.

Holocaust Center of The United Jewish Federation

Provides educational resources, sponsors community activities, and houses archives and cultural material related to the Holocaust.

Israel Scholarship Program

Provides assistance to high school and college students wishing to participate in accredited Israel experience programs.

Jewish Association on Aging*

Provides a network of services and facilities for the aging with an emphasis on Jewish values and independence.

Charles M. Morris Nursing and Rehabilitation Center

Provides nursing care, assisted living and related health services for residents who are unable to live independently.

Harry and Jeanette Weinberg Terrace

Provides assisted living apartments for residents who enjoy an independent lifestyle.

Jewish Cemetery and Burial Association of Greater Pittsburgh

Offers maintenance and management of cemeteries, and provides for the burial of indigent Jews.

Jewish Community Center of Greater Pittsburgh*

Offers a full range of programs and services that enhance Jewish identity, Jewish education, and all aspects of Jewish community life. Facilities include: Jewish Community Center of the South Hills, Henry Kaufmann Family Recreation Park and Emma Kaufmann Camp.

Jewish Family & Children's Service*

Provides comprehensive social services to the Jewish community, including New Americans, the elderly, children and victims of domestic violence. Also operates the Career Development Center, the Squirrel Hill Food Pantry, and administers Central Scholarship and Loan Referral Service.

Jewish Residential Services*

Develops residential facilities, supported living and social and vocational rehabilitation programs for adults with special needs in the Jewish community. Facilities include the Howard Levin Clubhouse and Leonard Staisey House.

Kollel Jewish Learning Center

Offers Judaic classes and seminars to area Jews regardless of background and affiliation.

Riverview Towers*

Provides independent living housing and support services for older Jews who meet specific income requirements.

Synagogue Federation Education Enrichment Fund

Provides funding for congregational schools.

Yeshiva Schools*

Operates a preschool and provides Judaic, general, and college preparatory education, with separate facilities for boys and girls in grades Kindergarten through 12.

Highlights

2006 - 2007

Financial Resource Development

During the past fiscal year (July 1, 2006 to June 30, 2007) the UJF's Financial Resource Development efforts secured \$40 million, a \$4.5 million increase, to meet vital human service needs. The funding was provided through the UJF Annual Community Campaign, the UJF Foundation, the Israel Emergency Campaign, the Jewish Healthcare Foundation, the United Way, private foundations, supplemental gifts, corporate sources and government grants.

2007 Annual Community Campaign

For the 11th consecutive year, the UJF Annual Community Campaign surpassed all previous totals to achieve its \$12.4 million goal. Generous Campaign donors enable UJF's local, national and overseas partner agencies to maintain and expand programs and services. This year, the Campaign received a significant boost from a PNC Bank challenge grant.

Israel Emergency Campaign

The United Jewish Federation joined with Federations throughout North America in launching the Israel Emergency Campaign to address the immediate and long-term human service needs in Israel as a result of the summer 2006 war. More than \$5.5 million was raised in Pittsburgh, contributing to a North American total of \$380 million.

UJF Foundation

The UJF Foundation, Pittsburgh's Jewish community foundation and one of the largest distributors of foundation funds in Pittsburgh, had an exceptional year. It surpassed its goal by adding more than \$16.8 million to its assets, bringing its total assets to more than \$139 million.

Community Building and Funding

As one of Pittsburgh's largest philanthropies, the UJF distributed more than \$24 million in 2007 to our partner service providers in Pittsburgh, Israel and throughout the world. UJF community building efforts have created enhanced collaborative efforts with our beneficiary agencies in areas of fiscal management, supplemental funding, programming, advocacy, and tending to the needs of our most vulnerable populations. Looking toward Israel, the UJF continued its successful Partnership 2000 project, now in its 12th year, which is Pittsburgh's people-to-people connection to its sister communities of Karmiel and Misgav. Additionally, the UJF's i-connect program, a community-wide approach to Israel engagement, developed several new initiatives focused on engaging teens with Israel.

Outreach

Setting as a top priority outreach to Jews who have little or no connection to community life, the UJF established concrete goals resulting in collaborative, community-wide efforts in partnership with local synagogues and Jewish organizations. Funding was secured, innovative programs were created and training sessions were held to establish a continual outreach process in the community. One particular outreach effort launched this past year by UJF's Shalom Pittsburgh and UJF Women was *The Buddies Program*. The program welcomes newcomers into the Pittsburgh Jewish community and offers them a personal connection.

Missions

Fifty-eight individuals – 23 of them first-time visitors to Israel – traveled on Mission Aviv, the largest UJF-hosted community mission to Israel in nearly 10 years. Also this year, five local congregational rabbis comprised the single largest delegation from any North American city to a national Rabbinic Mission in conjunction with the Israel Emergency Campaign.

GaliLead

Twenty-three Israeli Arabs and Jews from Northern Israel visited Pittsburgh for 11 days this past year as part of an innovative leadership program. Now in its second year and created in partnership by the UJF, Carnegie Mellon University and United Jewish Communities, GaliLead is designed to foster mutual understanding and respect among Israel's future leaders.

Community and Public Affairs

This year the UJF Community and Public Affairs Council coordinated a litter cleanup program that led to bonding between the neighborhoods of Homewood and Squirrel Hill – and earned CPAC the Jewish Council for Public Affairs' highest national award in Jewish community relations.

Holocaust Center of Pittsburgh

The Holocaust Center of Pittsburgh marked its 25th anniversary by bringing to Pittsburgh, in collaboration with the Andy Warhol Museum, the powerful U.S. Holocaust Memorial Museum's exhibition *Deadly Medicine: Creating the Master Race*. More than 23,000 individuals viewed the exhibition. Also in conjunction with the anniversary, the Center held an anniversary event featuring former Canadian Justice Minister Irwin Cotler, one of the world's leading human rights advocates. The Holocaust Center also commissioned and premiered an original play, *Mazel*, with the Jewish Theater of Pittsburgh. The play, inspired by the published stories of local survivors, presented to a new generation the personal experiences of horror and survival that will help assure that future generations will remember the lessons of the Holocaust.

Building and Strengthening Israel and Overseas Jewish Communities

The United Jewish Federation Annual Community Campaign supports a variety of human services for Jews in Israel, Central and Eastern Europe, Latin America, the Former Soviet Union (FSU), as well as other regions where Jews are in need. The Jewish Agency For Israel (JAFI) and the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee (JDC) are our two largest beneficiaries. They receive their regular support through our allocation to the United Jewish Communities, our national umbrella organization. In response to the crisis in Northern Israel that occurred as a result of the Second Lebanon war, the United Jewish Federation provided emergency support through the Israel Emergency Campaign (IEC).

In addition, the Federation provides a direct linkage between Pittsburgh and Jewish communities in Israel and throughout the world. For a sixth consecutive year, in response to our donors' desire to impact religious unity in Israel and otherwise advance our community's interests overseas, we make a direct allocation from our Federation to a variety of programs that are outlined in the following material.

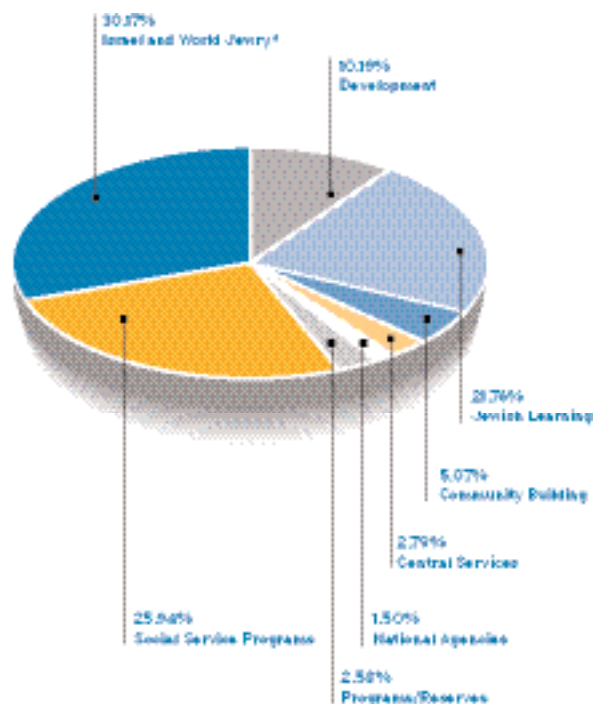

Israel Emergency Campaign

2006 - 2007

A major crisis threatened Israel this past year with the 34-day Second Lebanon War. Nearly 4,000 Hezbollah rockets were launched against population centers in Northern Israel, killing 159 Israelis, wounding another 4,000, and causing billions of dollars in property damage. Residents in our Partnership 2000 sister communities of Karmiel and Misgav, for the first time, found themselves in a war zone. They were targeted, daily, with attacks, resulting in a considerable emotional and economic toll. The war also turned another half million Israelis into refugees who were forced to evacuate to safer regions in the country.



Israel Emergency Campaign



In response, the UJF launched the Israel Emergency Campaign (IEC), as part of a North American effort coordinated by United Jewish Communities. The Pittsburgh Jewish community united behind

this effort and raised more than \$5.5 million dollars, the most funds it has ever raised in a special effort on behalf of Israel. Pittsburgh's achievement was part of a \$380 million North American result for the IEC.

With guidance from our service partners in Israel, the Jewish Agency for Israel and the American Jewish Joint Distribution Committee, the IEC has provided funding throughout Israel for emergency war-time needs such as the evacuation of children from war zones; emergency medical equipment; the upgrading of bomb shelters; and support for the victims and their families. Post-war, support included psychological help for vulnerable populations, assistance to those who have suffered economically; enhancement of after school activities and educational programs; financial assistance to college students affected by the war; and aid for communities to rebuild structures which provide social services. The UJF also provided directed funding to Pittsburgh's Partnership 2000 communities of Karmiel and Misgav for these services which was also augmented by United Jewish Communities. In the south of Israel, IEC funding helped the residents of Sderot and those living near the Gaza border as they faced attacks during 2007 from Kassam rockets.

Beyond the financial support provided by the Pittsburgh Jewish community to the Israeli people, local synagogues and community agencies demonstrated their support by hanging IEC banners on their buildings and encouraging thousands to reach out to our Israeli brothers and sisters. Thousands attended UJF-sponsored Israel Emergency Campaign programs and communicated frequently on an individual basis with friends and relatives in Israel. Also, scores of Pittsburgh Jews, in small groups and in larger missions, traveled to Israel to visit the war-stricken region and lend moral support to the war victims.

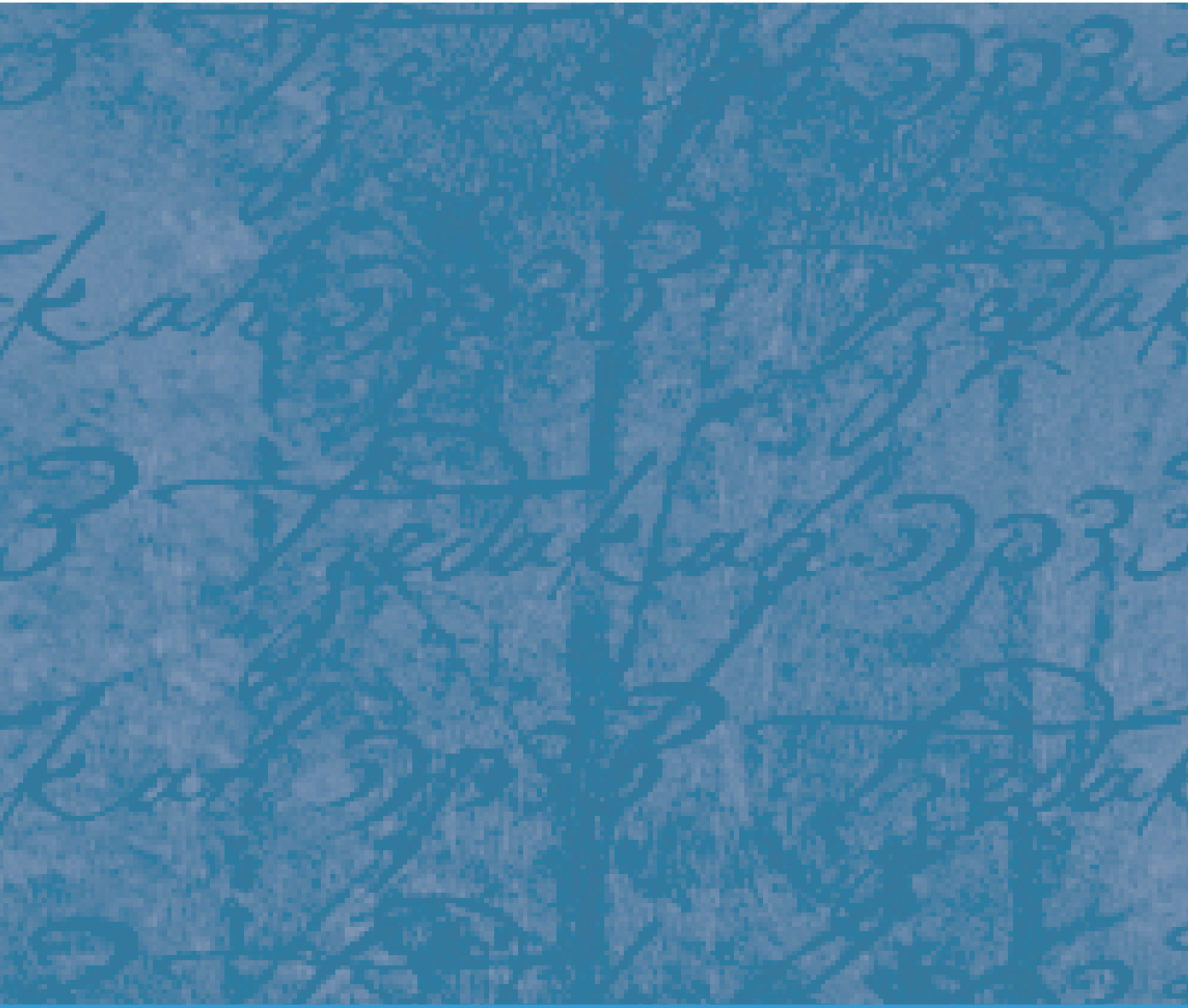
